Welcome

The reopening of school is a red-letter day on the calendar every year. It marks new beginnings, a fresh start filled with opportunities and potential. I would like to welcome back all our returning children & families, as well as, extend a very big welcome to all those who are joining us for the first time. On a personal note, I am delighted to have been appointed as Principal of Lucan ETNS and to be joining such a wonderfully supportive staff and well established learning community.

Recruitment - Teacher Shortages

As many of you may have read or heard in the news recently schools are facing significant challenges in filling vacant teaching posts at present. Lucan ETNS is no exception and although we have made some new appointments during the summer we are finding it incredibly difficult to fill all vacant positions. We are continuing to advertise posts in the hope of filling these positions. We have had to prioritise the allocation of class teachers to be able to re-open and provide as much consistency for the children as possible, however, this means we have a very depleted SET team. At our full complement we would have a SET team of seven who would be able to support children who need it the most, however, at present we are operating with just one. In addition to this the lack of available substitute teachers means that there may be days this year where we have no support teachers available. I think it's important that you, our school community, are aware of and understand that this situation which impacts on the learning of all children is outside of our control. We are asking a lot of our staff to help bridge the gap and to minimise the impact and we would welcome your support or your highlighting of this issue.
