I went with seven other outstanding pupils to Lucan Library for the annual quiz competition. Here's what happened!



The Board of Management met in person on Thursday, 27th February 2025. Below is their agreed reports

- The Board would like to thank all staff for their continuous dedication and care.
- The Board were pleased to learn that the Department funded solar panels will be installed during the Easter Break and will continue to research the possibility of extending this project.
- The Board would like to congratulate Karen Hayes & Sarah Quinn on their recent appointments to the in-school management team and wish them the very best in their roles.
- The Board considered all non-statutory leave requests for 2025/26.
- The Board discussed admissions for Cosáin and Junior Infants in 2025/26 and learned that all available spaces have been accepted and waiting lists are now in place.
- The Board learned that attendance levels are continuing to improve and would like to thank everyone for their support.
- The Board learned that our SET allocation for 2025/26 remains unchanged from 2024/25. A cluster arrangement with another school is still to be confirmed.
- The Board discussed the introduction of Restorative Practice (RP) and welcomed recent whole staff training
  on the subject. The Board agreed to support the investment in staff training to support the delivery of RP
  across the school.
- The Board were disappointed to learn that the NCSE led ANA review has been delayed once more and hope it is rescheduled as soon as possible.
- The Board would like to thank all parents who have come forward to provide talks to children and support for school projects in recent weeks, your support is greatly welcomed.

- The Board learned that the floors are to be replaced in three classrooms this year and works will take place in October at the earliest.
- The Board approved the use of an additional room for Sherpa Kids to support before and after school childcare provision.
- The Board are looking forward to Sports Week 2025 and the first Derek Mannion Shield GAA Blitz for 3rd 6th Class in Lucan Sarsfields.
