with your suggestions and feedback. We hope to start the roll out from the 26th January. I hope it provides great benefits for our children and families.

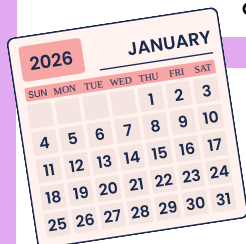
Cosáin Admissions
